



FOSSIL CORAL

Fossil coral, collected near Asa Zag, Morocco. It's approximately 320 million years old. The polishing allows for the beautiful, inner structure of the coral colony to be seen. It looks very similar to the fossil coral "Petoskey stones" found in Michigan, though a slightly different genus of coral. The genus is Actinocyathus, a type of rugose coral. This rock consists of a fossilized coral known as Hexagonaria from Hexagonaria was a common constituent of coral reefs in the Devonian period.



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
